BRI (Blossoming Rose Inc.) is a community-centered organization dedicated to improving mental health awareness, access, and education within underserved and minority communities. Rooted in compassion, cultural humility, and lived experience, BRI was created to break the stigma surrounding mental health and provide safe, affirming spaces for healing and growth. Our core values include integrity, advocacy, empowerment, collaboration, cultural awareness, and generational impact. We are committed to nurturing resilience, restoring hope, and helping individuals not just survive — but truly blossom.

Position Summary:

Our mission is to empower individuals and families ages 15–50 through therapy services, support groups, crisis support, and transformative community programs. We believe that healing happens in community — and that everyone deserves access to culturally responsive care, emotional support, and opportunities for personal development.

The Community Engagement Coordinator helps expand the impact and visibility of Blossoming Rose Inc. by building strong community relationships and increasing program participation. This role supports outreach efforts, attends organizational and community events, and works closely with the Executive Director to create new partnerships and connections. **This position requires approximately 10-20 hours per week, with additional time during events as needed.**

Position Responsibilities:

This role focuses on building meaningful community connections, expanding outreach efforts, and representing BRI at events to increase awareness and program participation.

- ◇ Build partnerships with schools, churches, community centers, domestic violence organizations, and local nonprofits
- ◇ Develop referral relationships with social workers, DCS workers, probation officers, and case managers
- ◇ Attend and represent BRI at health fairs, resource events, and networking opportunities
- ◇ Help identify donated or low-cost spaces for programs and events
- ◇ Increase enrollment in BRI support groups (men's, women's, parents, special needs families, etc.)
- ◇ Promote programs like Heal the Roots and other educational workshops
- ◇ Assist in outreach for quarterly self-care and personal development events
- ◇ Track participation and community engagement metrics
- ◇ Assist in planning and executing community events and fundraisers
- ◇ Recruit and coordinate volunteers
- ◇ Support logistics for workshops and group sessions
- ◇ Help reduce mental health stigma in minority communities
- ◇ Distribute educational materials and resources
- ◇ Gather community feedback to inform programming
- ◇ Support advocacy efforts aligned with BRI's mission
- ◇ Assist with grassroots marketing strategies
- ◇ Support social media engagement and community storytelling
- ◇ Help increase brand awareness for Blossoming Rose Inc.
